

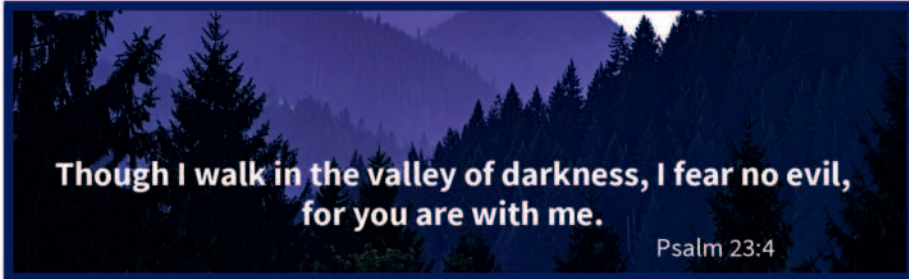

Why I Attend Church

The song "In This Place", is partly a statement that explains why I physically attend church: Here is a part of that song.

We are all hungry people; we need shelter and strength.

We are one in our hurting; we are one in our pain.

In our suffering and sadness, we are saved by the grace of the power and the Spirit that is here in this place.

.....

We are gathered at table as one in the Lord.

We are gathered as people who are living the Word.

Our hearts and our spirits are nurtured by grace.

It is Jesus who fills us. He is here in this place.

There are a number of possible reasons why I want to be physically present in a Catholic church on the Sabbath, but all possible reasons boil down to two. Some of the possible reasons are because Church rules say it could be a mortal sin to miss Mass, or because I want to be seen by others, or even because I wanted the doughnuts after Mass!

For those who may have been raised with a religious background but no longer, or rarely, attend Church, the thought that I can pray anywhere so I don't need to be inside a church on a weekend is a nice one, but rarely put into practice. For me, one main reason for attending church is not some legalistic obligation, or to see the liturgical decorations –it's done for the deep sense of peace, community, and renewal that comes from being there.

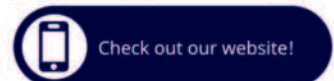

When I attend Mass, I look around me and feel the support of others looking for the same thing – peace, regeneration, and strength to put in another day or week. I see it in most of their faces, as I hope they see it in mine. It's sort of like seeing good neighbors across the street and waving greetings to them. They care how I'm doing, as I do about them. Those feelings of care and concern for people we've come to know are things that are rarely present watching a Mass on the computer or shopping in a mall.

The other main reason I like to physically attend church is that "in this place" we are saved and strengthened by the Eucharist we receive – the body and blood of Our Lord himself.

Yes, one can always make a spiritual communion, but nothing replaces physically taking in the body and soul of Jesus. It is our Lord, present in the bread and wine; present in his people; and finally, present in me, that fills and nurtures me. It can't be bought, virtualized or substituted.

We can stream religious presentations, watch a Tik Tok video, YouTube snippets of a Mass, or talk about information in the church bulletin, but nothing comes up to the level of physically being present in church for the Mass. There is no substitute. It is why I attend church.

Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA

Our parish will take up the Collection for the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA (AMS), a collection approved by the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops to be taken every three years.

The AMS provides pastoral care to Catholic men and women serving in the U.S. Armed Forces, enrolled at a U.S. Military Academy, being treated as a patient at any of the 153 U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs Medical Centers, or who work for the federal government beyond U.S. borders — including those from our own parish and diocese.

The AMS does not receive any funding from the government or military, and has no parishes from which to receive a weekly assessment.
