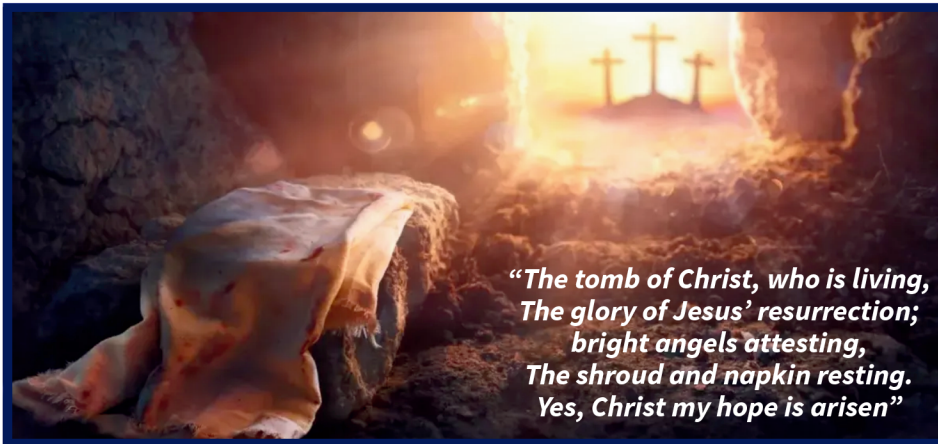

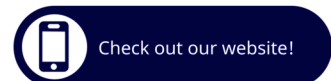

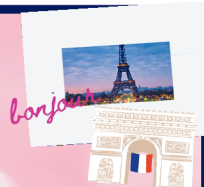

A Prayer for Peace, Courage, and Solidarity

In all things, may we be guided by the peace of Christ, who meets us in our fear,
breaks down dividing walls, and calls us to love one another.

In this Easter season, we are reminded that the risen Christ first came to his disciples in a moment of fear and uncertainty and spoke words of peace: "Peace be with you."

Today, many in our communities, including refugees, immigrants, and others who feel vulnerable, are experiencing fear and uncertainty in response to current events and public policies. As people of faith, we are called to respond not with fear, but with prayer, compassion, and a commitment to see one another as beloved children of God.

This prayer is being shared by local faith leaders who are part of JOSHUA (Justice Organization Sharing Hope and United for Action), a network of congregations in the Greater Green Bay area working together for the well-being of our community.

We offer this prayer as an invitation – not as a statement of uniform perspective, but as an opportunity for congregations to join in seeking God's peace, wisdom, and guidance for all people, especially those who are feeling afraid or uncertain.

Prayer for the weekend of April 11 & 12

God of Peace, as the disciples gathered on that first Easter behind locked doors for fear of the authorities, so this day, many brothers and sisters, such as refugees, immigrants, and undocumented persons, also live in fear of those who are in authority. As the risen Christ came and spoke words of comfort and hope on that night, we pray that you would be with all those who are fearful this day, giving them your peace and assurance, and that you would strengthen the resolve of those who stand with them to break down the doors and walls dividing your children.

Across northeastern Wisconsin, refugees and other immigrants are rebuilding their lives with courage and determination. Yet the journey toward belonging is often marked by loss, resilience, and the search for community.
