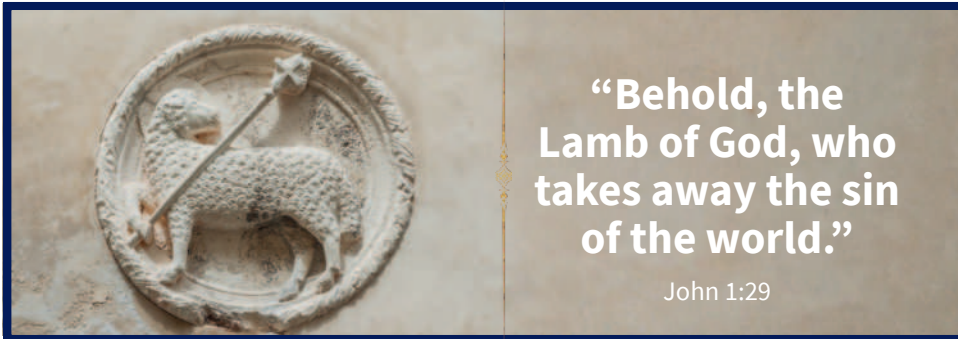

Movable Feasts

Happy New Year!!!!

So, after twenty-eight years of priesthood a couple of Saturdays ago as I was preparing for the feast of the Epiphany, I learned something new as I read the "ORDO" that is the Order of Prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours and Celebration of the Eucharist, basically the book that tells us what Mass we are to celebrate and what our options are on any given day. As I was reading the ORDO that day it said: "On the Epiphany, there is an ancient custom of announcing the dates of movable feasts for the coming year. This proclamation has been used in connection with the blessing and distribution of calendars. This Epiphany Proclamation may take place after the reading of the Gospel or within or after the homily. It may be sung by the deacon, presider, or cantor from the ambo." As you know many of our feast days do have fixed dates, for example, All Saints Day on Nov. 1st, and Christmas on Dec. 25, Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary on August 15th, but in addition to this is a list of movable feasts. Also, please note that other than the feasts we celebrate on Sunday, none of these movable feasts is a Holy Day of Obligation.

Of course, Epiphany has come and gone. Last weekend I did read a partial list of the movable feast days, but on page 2 is a complete list of the movable feasts in 2026. And again, happy new year.

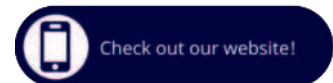
