A Modern Temptation

Once again, on this First Sunday of Lent, we revisit the temptations of Jesus as we begin another season of Lent. Lent is supposed to be a sort of preparation – a cleansing of ourselves as we prepare for the central event of Christianity, the Resurrection of Our Lord at Easter.

We typically do this cleansing by giving up something we really like or doing something affirmative for others. With that in mind, let's look at a modern temptation: the temptation to polarize in our society.

Under the present-day circumstances in our country, many of us have (knowingly or not) placed ourselves in political and cultural “silos” where we tend to associate with like-minded people. These silos are present at work, in families, and even in the Church. Each side justifies itself with argument, protest, and information from social media. These silos can divide families, parishes, and even the Church, and this only benefits the Tempter.

This Lent, our action to cleanse ourselves and be ready for Easter could be this: Find Common Ground. This means suspending judgment over who is right and who is wrong and instead finding out if you and the opposing person have anything in common.

This can mean, for example, the same hobby, a common (non-silo) past experience, the same school you two attended, or a similar family background. Then, once this bridge has been found, talk about the matter you two hold in common – not divisive cultural events.

Like Jesus in the desert, pray for the strength to be kind. Look for the positive in others, disregarding for the moment their political beliefs. Recall that the other person is, like me, a human being, with the dignity, rights, and equality that are within all human beings. And remember too that the Spirit of God is in charge – not me or the people in my silo. Then, perhaps, at Easter we too can gaze in awe at the empty tomb and realize that Jesus came to save EVERYONE, not just the people in my political silo. Shepherd us O God!
