

## Thirsting for Living Water

The gospel this weekend begins with Jesus, tired, exhausted and thirsty. He sat down at a well. As we enter the third week of Lent, do you feel like Jesus, tired and exhausted? Yet even though exhausted, he addresses a broken, lonely, and ashamed woman. He asks, "Give me a drink." It is an invitation to be at risk. It is an invitation to cross boundaries and ancient taboos. He is thirsty and she has a bucket and there is the well that was built by their mutual ancestor Jacob.

The woman Jesus encounters knows no respect. Yet Jesus reaches out to her from his need, not hers. By reaching out to her from his need he gives her dignity and respect. There is something she can do for him. Jesus gives her identity and purpose. Suddenly something new, something real, wells up inside her. It is a new confidence, a new spirit. And from this new spirit her real thirst is revealed. It is a thirst that will not be quenched by the waters at the bottom of Jacob's well. She thirsts for real life, authentic life, and Jesus gives it to her without cost and without condition. Unconditional Love!

A couple weeks ago 10 Res Missionaries (volunteers) experienced Jesus's unconditional love in Okolona, MS, as they worked with five sisters, to bring light to an impoverished community. One member of the Res team said, "what a great way to begin Lent," giving alms (serving) and praying together each day. As we prepare for this week, reflect for a moment. Jesus wants to reveal himself to each of us. Do we recognize him? He speaks to us through the scriptures at Mass this weekend, through the parish mission, and through our encounters with each other. He invites each of us to quench our thirst as we receive him.


