
# Fourth Sunday of Advent December 20 & 21, 2025



# Feasts of the Christmas Season

Hello, and happy Advent. I hope you and yours are well as we make straight the paths of the Lord in our life this Advent season. I thought I would mention some of the feasts of the Christmas season soon to be upon us.

Of course, the first feast is the most obvious and important one, the Nativity of the Lord, more commonly known as Christmas, which we celebrate on Dec. 25th. On this feast we celebrate the incarnation: God becomes a human being in the person of our Lord Jesus Christ while remaining God for the purpose of our salvation.

The next day we celebrate the feast of Saint Stephen the first martyr. St. Stephen, martyred about the year 35, was one of the seven deacons mentioned in the book Acts of the Apostles. He entrusted his life to the Lord for the sake of spreading the Gospel.

The following day, the 27th, we celebrate the feast of St. John the Evangelist. John the Evangelist, "the disciple whom Jesus loved," died around the year 90. He is the author of the fourth Gospel, the three letters that appear near the end of the New Testament bearing his name, and the Book of Revelation. His Gospel is symbolized by an eagle as it soars to the heights of Christ's divinity.

Sunday the 28th is the feast of the Holy Family: Jesus, Mary, and Joseph. Family life is rooted in the unconditional love of God as witnessed by the Holy Family. Please note that the feast of the Holy Innocents is omitted this year, as it lands on a Sunday. However, prayers for the innocent who have perished through abortion, starvation, and war are encouraged.

December 29th, 30th and 31st are the fifth, sixth, and seventh days of the Octave of Christmas, which ends the following day, Thursday Jan. 1st, as we celebrate Mary the Mother of God. May we seek God's blessings as Mary did. Please note this feast is a Holy Day of Obligation.

Sunday, Jan. 4th, marks the feast of the Epiphany of the Lord. All nations are invited to sing the Lord's praises for they have been called to hear the good news and worship the long-awaited Messiah and King with the gift of their lives.
