#### **Amazing Grace** by Deacon Kevin DeCleene

During a recent homily, many sang Amazing Grace with me. Beautiful! Yet, we all experience obstacles to God's grace, such as anything that keeps us from enjoying the loving relationship God offers us in Christ. What do we call an obstacle to grace? It's probably the biggest 3 letter word in our vocabulary.

Sin = self-centeredness rather than God-centeredness. Some have described sin as the "big I" sIn, —making myself the center of the universe and the standard for supreme goodness instead of acknowledging God as the rightful center of all creation.

When I was twenty-something, I had a job as a mechanic. The small shop had financial trouble. I was the last mechanic so the couple of small tools, a caliper, and a special micrometer would not be missed by the closing shop as I moved to a new job. My rationale was that the place was closing and the owner was not a mechanic, so I left a couple of small tools that the shop owned in my toolbox.

A couple of years later, I ran into an old co-worker from the shop. They told me how angry the owner was with all the people that stole from him when they moved on. My heart sank. Oh Lord, what had I done? I had never even used the small tools I stole. So I turned to prayer, went to reconciliation, and made the decision to package up the tools and mail them to the owner, along with a note of apology and a \$100 bill. As God would have it, I was at a seminar a couple of months later and ran into the owner, who was so joyful that I returned the goods and reconciled with him. I could feel the Holy Spirit present in the interaction. I was embarrassed, but the owner was sincerely joyful with me.


