## Who is Free?

In John's Gospel [8:32] Jesus told the Jewish leaders debating with him over his identity that if they remained in his word (followed what he said), they would know the truth and the truth would set them free.

In these divided times many are concerned about being free, about their freedom. They perceive society and particularly the government as imposing upon their personal freedom to do and say what they want. There can be three mistakes in that thinking.

First, this approach is only concerned with my own personal freedom. If someone else is oppressed by, for example, Jim Crow rules or racism, immigration barriers, or anti-transgender laws, that is their problem. Yet there is an old saying: No one is free when others are oppressed. If someone persists in crying for the "right" to do or say whatever they want, in effect they are asking for superior rights to others. This idea of freedom founders on the rock of the common good (the concept that the overall well-being and peace of most people is tied to respecting each human being).

Second, the truth of freedom is not in saying or doing what you want; it is in being. Being free means we are not under compulsion to act, such as when addictions, ideology, the pursuit of power or prejudices motivate our actions.

The third mistake is the idea that somehow, the "right" to use demonizing language is a "right" in the first place. There is no right to say whatever we want, at the cost of public peace. Every real "right" carries with it the obligation of a duty to protect that same right in someone else.

What Jesus was trying to get across was that as long as these leaders disregarded others in need because of religious rules or political beliefs, they were not free.

It is the understanding that we are all on the same life journey and we all need help getting to our destination. That can allow us the freedom to be kind, gentle, and forgiving, like Jesus. Living as Jesus did is the true path to freedom — his truth will set us free.

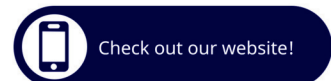

Thank you to all who volunteered and participated! And a special thanks to Kevin Erb and the Care for Creation committee for leading this event.

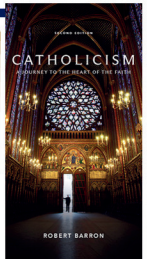
