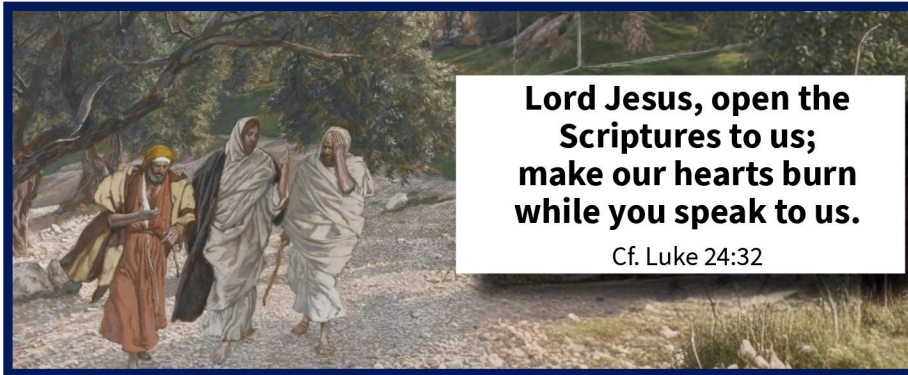

Pay It Forward

As our God “paid it forward” by sending his only son to walk with us, I had a “pay it forward” opportunity while on a recent trip to Madison. I noticed my low gas light, so it was time to stop at the next exit. I was running late, so this needed to be quick. As I was gassing up the car, a young person pulled in with a flat tire. They had been driving on it a while because the tire was shredded. My initial prayer was, “Lord, please bless them with a good spare and the knowledge to change it.” I mean, it was 12 degrees out, and I was running late. After looking around the gas station to see if someone might help, I heard them say, “I have no clue how to change this tire!”

I zipped up my jacket, pulled up my hood, and walked over. Of course, it was not going to be an easy fix either. The aluminum wheel was corroded to the hub. After I tried wiggling it, I tried slamming my heel into it (bad idea), and I tried a small sledge hammer, but it would not budge. Finally, a young man, much stronger than I, came over and was able to use his leg power to jar it loose. After completing the job, I told the young woman to “pay it forward.” Do a random act of kindness. Maybe a simple smile to someone, or sharing some food with someone in need. She was very grateful.

In the Gospel story, Road to Emmaus, we meet two disciples walking away from Jerusalem, weighed down by confusion and disappointment. They had hoped in Jesus, but the Cross shattered their expectations. As they walk, the risen Christ draws near—but they do not recognize Him. How often does this happen in our own lives? The Lord is with us, even in our struggles, yet many times we fail to see Him.

This Gospel reveals a pattern for our own journey: we walk with questions, we listen to God’s Word, we encounter Christ in the Eucharist, and we are sent forth in mission. Wherever you are today—confused, hopeful, searching, maybe an opportunity to change someone’s flat tire—know that Jesus walks beside you. Invite Him in. Listen for His voice. And let your heart burn again with the joy of His presence. Pay it Forward!

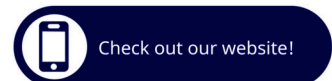
