




This weekend's Gospel shows us Jesus sending out 72 disciples (evidently his preaching and teaching was having some effect!) to help bring the Good News of the Reign of God to all people. This mission didn't require any special



This weekend, as we welcome Fr. Bob Kollath, our new pastor, we might ask how this Gospel relates to us? After all, I'm not out preaching from town to town. The answer? This is not a "mission impossible." All this mission requires of us is that we try each day to pattern ourselves after the Master. In the face of anger, show someone patience. In the face of selfishness, show kindness, and in the face of being wronged. show forgiveness.

We don't have to save the world on this mission — Jesus has already done that. Our mission is one on one, to bring a little decency, a little love back into the world. 


