

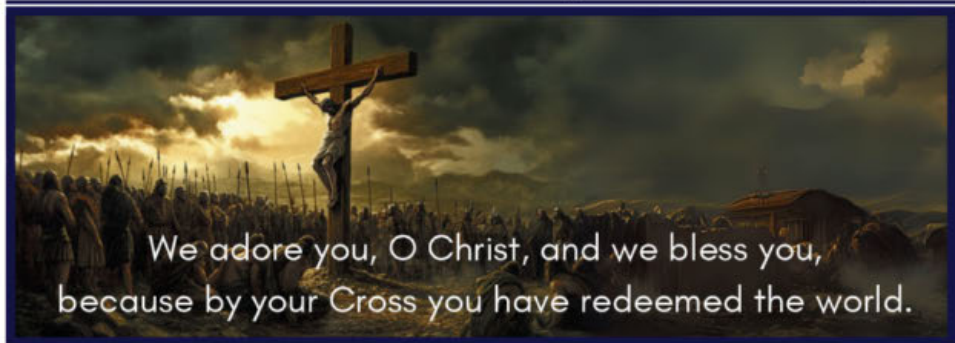

Part II - Hearing God's Voice

Turning away from a situation we could have done something about is referred to as the hardening of our hearts. It is a refusal to forgive and the holding tight of resentment. We hear but turn away, our hearts hardened by indifference, fear or doubt. Sebastian Moore, a Benedictine monk, has written: *Human forgiveness results in the unhardening of the heart of the human pardoner; divine forgiveness results in the unhardening of the heart of the one who is pardoned.*

Hardening of our hearts is a slow, insidious process. We can be going along in our day, with no bad intent, when a situation comes up that throws us out of balance. Maybe someone is interrupting our schedule — and maybe they've done this before. Suddenly we begin to think hard thoughts about this person. Thoughts like: they have no care for others, they are known for being pushy and selfish . . . and on and on. Suddenly we find our hearts hardened to this person.

God's voice may, in fact, be calling us to reach out to this person and set some time aside to listen to them. This is the meaning behind the phrase: If today you hear God's voice, harden not your hearts. It's so easy to get caught up in our own anger and impatience that the steps to a hard heart quickly flow through us. Worse than that, many of us then go on to try and justify our own hard-heartedness.

God is asking us to let go and let God be in charge. It's a trick that Satan plays on us — he makes it seem as if we are completely in the right and that it is therefore O.K. for us to stubbornly refuse to listen to the other. Who is in the right and who is wrong makes little sense when it leads to a hardening of our hearts. It leads to us acting self-righteously when in fact we are lacking in mercy.
