Introduction

If someone stumbled and feel in the street, would you help them, or feel embarrassed and walk on by? Jesus tells us that we must be ready to help whoever needs us because everyone is our neighbor.

Please read the gospel with your family

Gospel: Luke 10: 29-37

A reading from the Gospel of St. Luke.

A man once said to Jesus, "I know that I should love God with all my heart and love my neighbor too. But who is my neighbor?" Then Jesus told him this story: "One day a man was traveling from Jericho to Jerusalem, when a gang of robbers attached him. They beat him up and after stealing everything he had, they left him lying injured by the roadside. A short time later, one of the temple priests passed that way but he crossed the read and walked on by. Soon after another traveler came but he, too, passed on by. Then a Samaritan happened to pass and when he saw the injured man, he took pity on him. He bandaged his wounds and carried him on horseback to a nearby inn. There he cared for him, and when the time came to leave, he left the innkeeper enough money to pay for the man's room until he was better."

Jesus then asked the man, "Which man in the story was a good neighbor?" "The one who helped the wounded traveler," he answered. "Go, then, and do the same for anyone who needs your help," said Jesus.

All: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ!


Questions for Discussion

Lord, let me know when it is wise to help.








Draw a tow truck pulling a car to be fixed.



Circle the picture that is **different**. Then color in all the pictures.










If I see someone hurt, I will stop playing to get help.
