Dear Parishioners,

Have you ever heard a song in the morning and then couldn't get it out of your mind? Recently at the morning Mass we sang "There is a Longing" and the refrain kept playing in my head and my heart. It goes "There is a longing in our hearts, O Lord, for you to reveal yourself to us. There is a longing in our hearts for love we only find in you, our God."

Repeatedly it played within me. Why did it strike a chord in me? What was the song telling me? Our hymns so often reflect our Catholic theology calling us to be our truest selves. Here in these words and the haunting melody, we can be transformed into the people God has called us to be. The hymn was a welcome message replacing my sometimes doom and gloom narrative of the current events in our world. I can't always find God in the messiness of life. From annoying demands of technology updates on my phone, to disturbing treatment of the least of my sisters and brothers, to power and greedy decisions made by a few having global effects, I can feel totally overwhelmed and helpless.

That's when the refrain pulls me toward my Center, longing for God to be revealed. God never fails to be near the brokenhearted. The verses of the song name over and over again our need for God in our lives. "For justice, for freedom, for mercy...In sorrow, in grief, be near, hear our prayer, O God. For wisdom, for courage, for comfort, in weakness, in fear, be near, hear our prayer, O God."

This parish has been light to me for over 30 years revealing God in unnumbered ways. I have seen God through your love and generosity offering meals at local shelters for many years and in the eyes of the grateful recipients. God is revealed in the many volunteers who lovingly visit and bring Holy Communion to our homebound, hospitalized, and nursing home parishioners, or travel to Okolona or Honduras. I witness those grieving the loss of a loved one lean on God at their darkest time showing me again where God is, Love is.

Do you want this song to linger in your heart, too? Google "There is a longing in our hearts" and savor God's presence revealed in you and all creation.
