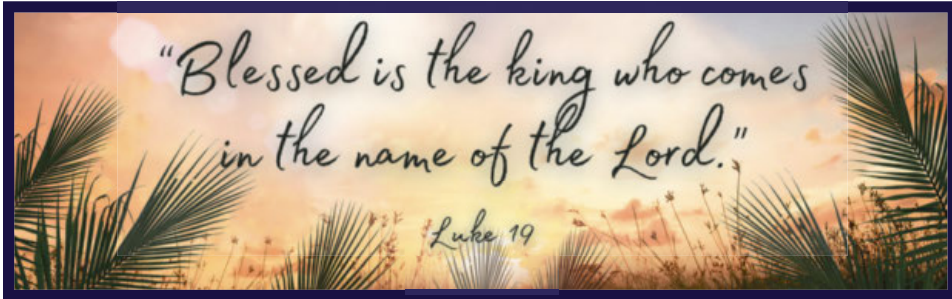

The Wins and Losses of Holy Week

I have followed the basketball career of Tony Bennett since the day he walked onto the campus of UWGB in the fall of 1988. I was there the night that Tony and the other Fighting Phoenix won the conference championship to earn the school's first trip to the NCAA Division I Tournament. Yep, that was me, in my mid-twenties, leaping over the media tables in the student section to join the mob of people at mid-court to celebrate.



Fast forwarding nearly 30 years, Tony's Virginia Cavalier team experienced the ultimate highs and lows, deaths and resurrections, of college basketball in the seasons of 2018 and 2019. In 2018 Tony's team entered the tournament of 64 teams as a highly regarded Number One seed. They were expected to go deep into the tournament and perhaps even win the whole thing. Except they did not. The Cavaliers became the first #1 seed to be knocked out in the first round by a #16 seed. Ouch! I was sick to my stomach that day. What an experience of dying. It took a whole year to get over the pain of that loss. And that was just me! Can you imagine how Tony Bennett and the team felt? I know his Dad, Dick, and his Mom, Ann, were certainly affected by their son's loss.

But then the resurrection! In the spring of 2019 Virginia was back in the tournament. After escaping a close first round match-up, they went on to win the entire tournament—a National Championship. From life to death to new life. THAT is the Paschal Mystery.

As we enter into the holiest of holy weeks of our Church year, we recall the triumphant entry into Jerusalem by Jesus and his closest followers. Those same people watch their friend, their Messiah, hang on a cross to die a horrific, torturous death. But that is not the end! There is a third day, when Jesus is raised from the dead to new life.

As we make the same paschal mystery journey this week, from life, to death, to new life, we recall our own experiences of death and resurrection. For some they may not be as dramatic as humiliation on national TV followed by the crowning as National Champion. For others, basketball is kids' games compared to the loss that they have experienced. But we remember our deaths and resurrections nonetheless. May you have a blessed Holy Week as we journey from life, to death, to new life on Easter Sunday.

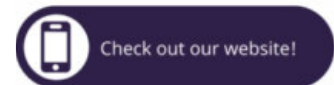

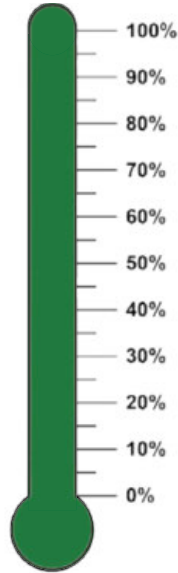
