The Parish – A Family of Families

This past week, the Vatican hosted an international gathering for households of faith of all sizes, ages, and nationalities for the 10th edition of the World Meeting of Families. Pope Francis kicked off the celebration, commissioning all participants to return to their home countries inspired by the Spirit, infused with a call to holiness, to be strengthened in their efforts to love one another, especially those on the margins and in most need of our care and concern.



The theme of this gathering was “Family Love: A Vocation and a Path to Holiness” and focused on Francis’ document Amoris Laetitia (“The Joy of Love”). This document asks the church to meet people where they are, in consideration of the complexities of their lives, and to respect the conscience of individuals when it comes to moral decisions. Amoris Laetitia reflects on the diversity of family life. It encourages us to avoid judging and imposing rules without considering the individual struggles of each family and its members.

So what difference do such international gatherings of families have for us at Resurrection Parish? Pope Francis reminds us that the parish is a “family of families”. We are called to faithfully welcome families of every condition and be open to befriending households, regardless of any type of difference. Francis wrote, “the family can discover, together with the Christian community, new approaches, new ways of acting, a different way of understanding and identifying with others, by welcoming and caring for the mystery of the frailty of human life.” (Chapter 2, #47)

Each of us has been gifted with certain talents and circumstances which enable us to support and lift others up, to welcome and include, to stand up against discrimination and exclusion, and to make a difference for those with fewer opportunities and resources.

The well-being of families and the stability of households determine the health of our community, our nation, and our world. Healthy relationships and access to adequate resources lead to natural goodness. We must share love and mercy with all of God’s children. Let us support one another in rising to the challenge of making our parish family known for its welcoming, hospitality, and inclusion of all God’s children.

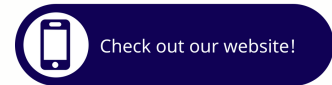
