

## The Raising of Lazarus

The gospel for this weekend—the Raising of Lazarus was beautifully celebrated and explained for all who attended the Parish Mission with Fr. Ed Shea.

Lazarus was a beloved friend of Jesus, and it was well known that he had a close relationship with him. When the sisters requested Jesus to come, that was a testament to their trust in Jesus and faith in his power to heal. When arriving Jesus saw their grief and the grief of the people around him, he cried.

Tears in the Bible symbolize a connection with God. They serve as expressions of joy, sorrow, repentance, and compassion.

I found myself interested in tears, being a person who can cry watching Hallmark Movies, and one who has always believed that God cries.

When searching the Bible I found four types of tears:

1. Tears of Joy (Psalm 126:5), “Those who sow in tears shall reap with shouts of joy.” These tears signify the deep emotion tied to being happy.
2. Tears of Sorrow (John 11:35), Jesus weeps at the loss of Lazarus. His tears show human grief and compassion, telling us that sorrow has a place in our faith.
3. Tears of Repentance (2 Cor.7:10), Paul writes about Godly sorrow leading to repentance. This type of tear represents remorse and the desire to change our hearts.
4. Tears of Compassion (Matt.9:36), Jesus shows compassion for a loss when others are suffering. These tears demonstrate empathy and love.

Embrace your tears as part of your journey and relationship with yourself and God. Tears are powerful! Allow yourself to cry. It’s a natural part of being human.

So next time you find yourself in tears remember they are a beautiful part of your story and your connection to God because God cries with you!


